WINTER-TRIP «CITY TRIP»

Our guides show you their city. Come with us on an interesting and unforgettable tour through Lucerne with the innovative Segway!

Our route begins at the Premium Business Centers and takes us to the Culture and Convention Centre, which was inaugurated in 2000. It unites art, culture, congress and fine food.

We then drive over the See bridge to the world renowned Lion monument, which was conceptualized by Danish sculptor Thorvaldsen in remembrance of the fallen Swiss heroes of the 1792 battle at Tuileries. Lukas Ahorn from Constance carved the lion into the natural rock of Luzern's former sandstone quarry. By the time of its solemn unveiling in 1821 "the mortally wounded lion of Luzern" had become the most famous commemorative monument in the world.

As the tour continues, the route takes us up the beautiful, winding roads of the Wesemlin-quartier, which is tailor made for Segway driving. The Wesemlin-quartier is an extremely popular residential area due to its sunny location, the many green areas close-by, the Dreilindenhügel and the Dietschiberg. Situated directly over the old city, the Wesemlinquartier offers a spectacular views of the lake and the mountains. Following our visit we return over the See Bridge to our starting point, where the tour finishes after 2 hours.

At one point of the tour we make a stop at a restaurant and enjoy a delicious hot beverage in order to warm up.
